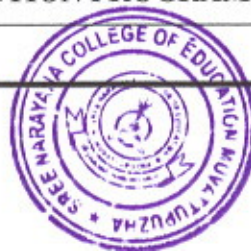
M Ed COURSE INDUCTION PROGRAM 2022-2024 (17/11/2022)

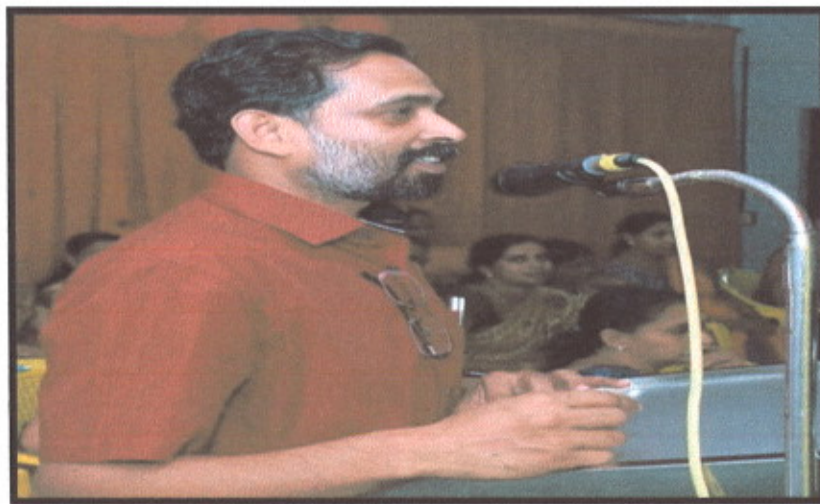

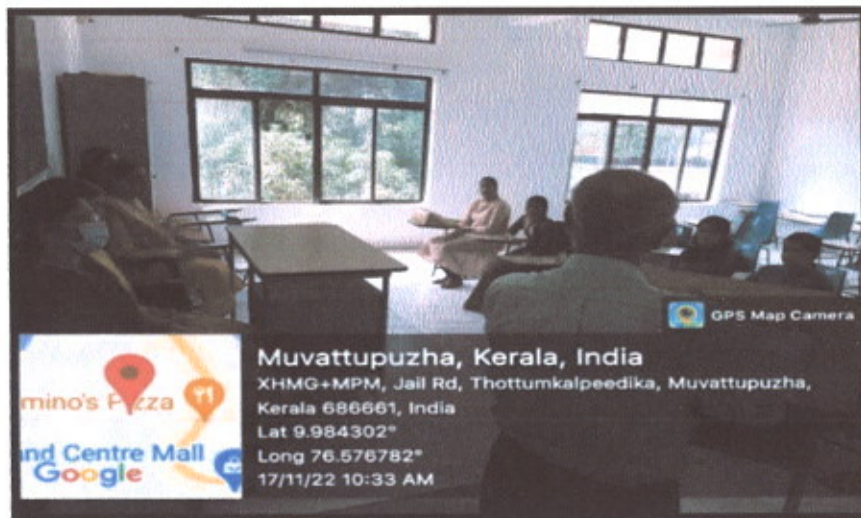
ORIENTATION OF M. Ed BATCH (17/11/2022)

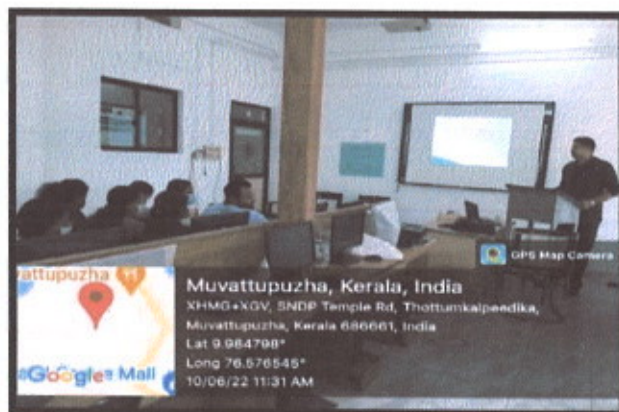

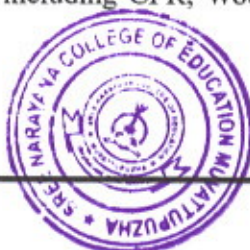

The B Ed program incorporates a 20-week school internship divided into two faces: a 4-week initial face during the second semester and a subsequent 16-week face during the 3rd semester. The aim is to develop a wide-ranging set of perspectives and professional competencies in prospective teachers during the internship. Student teachers assume the role of regular educators and engage in all aspects of teaching, including planning instruction and assessment. They also interact with school teachers, community members, and students. The supervision of practice teaching is a collaborative effort between SN College of Education and practice teaching in schools. The teacher educators provide continuous observation and feedback to enhance the teaching skills of novice teachers.
