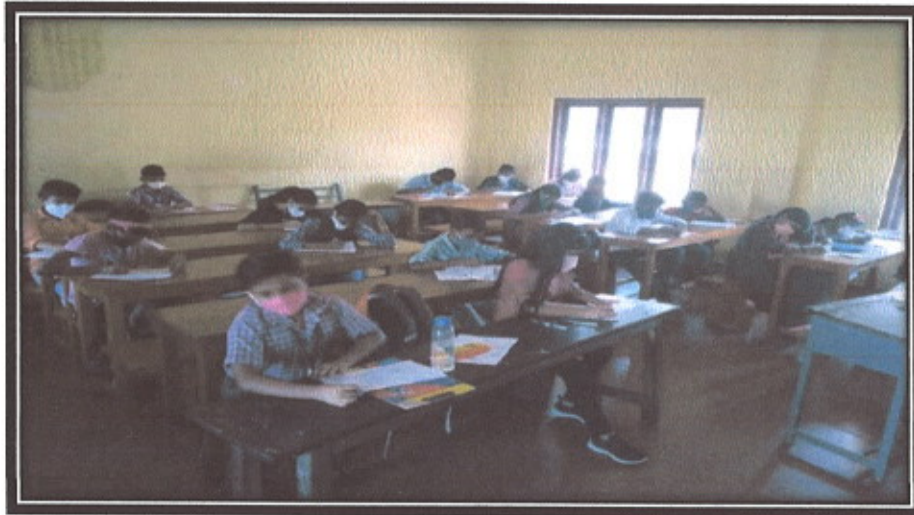

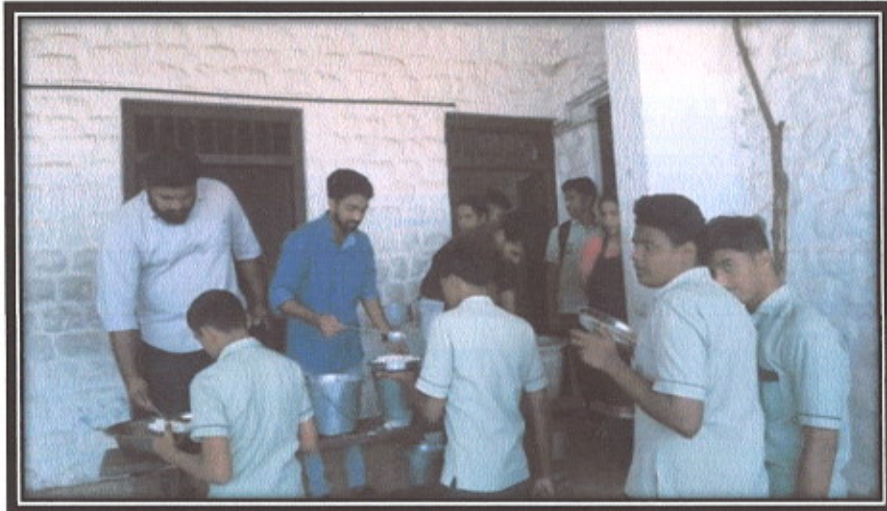

MORNING ASSEMBLY AND DISCUSSION WITH A SOCIALLY RELEVANT TOPIC

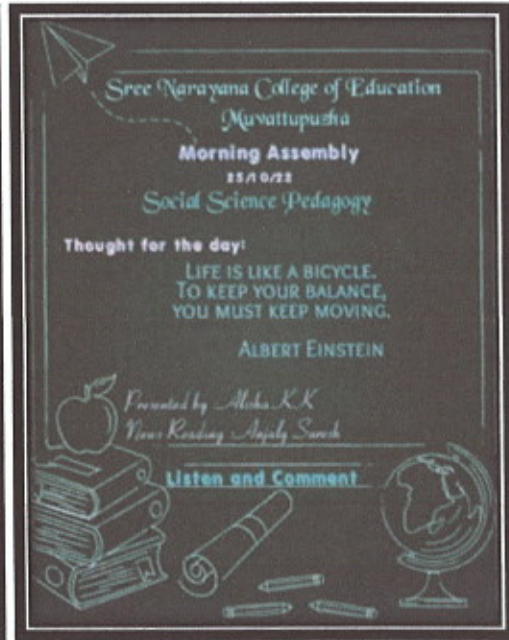
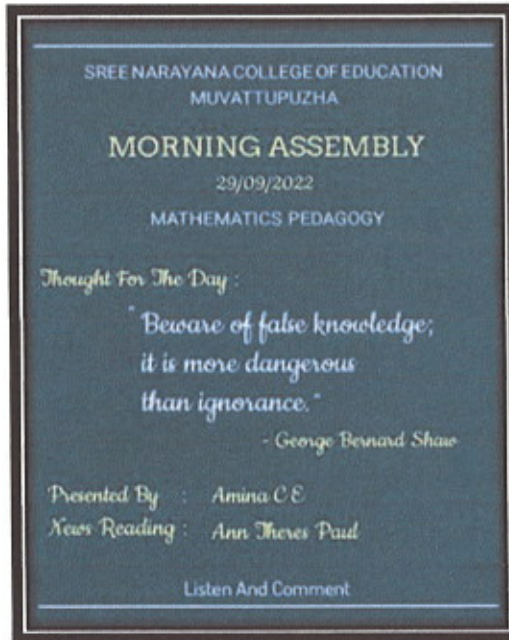

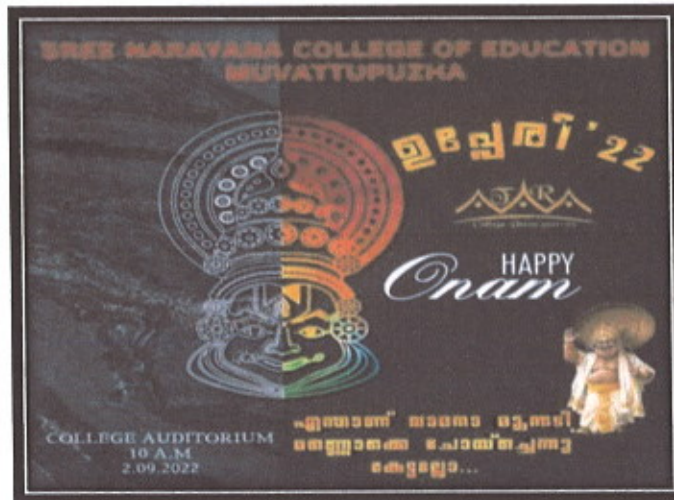
ONAM CELEBRATION

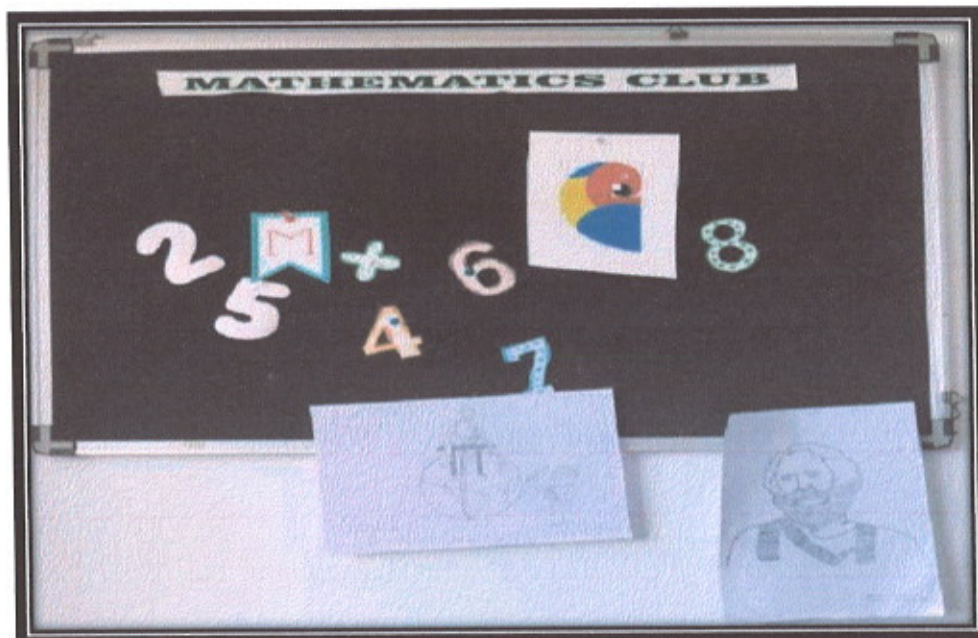

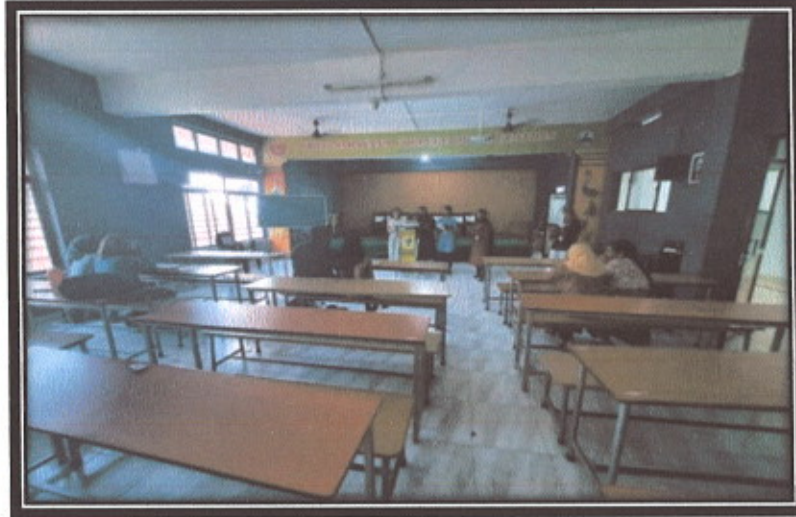

colourful posters. The occasion marks the day to raise awareness about the importance of weather and climate-related information and to promote international cooperation in these areas.



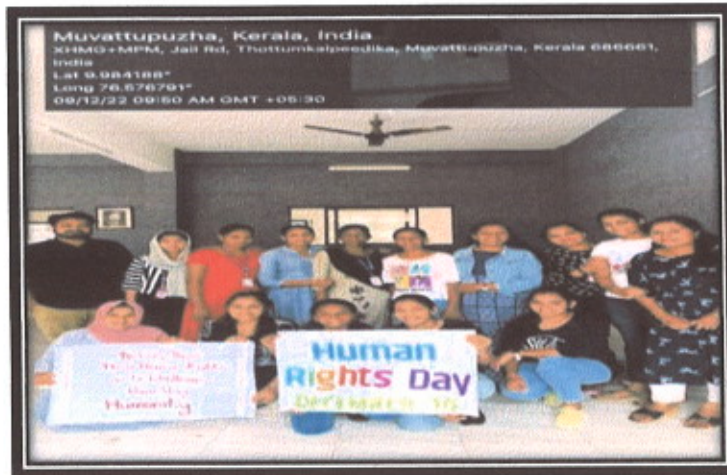
