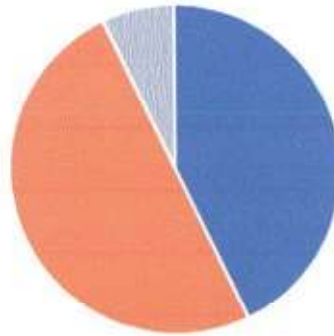

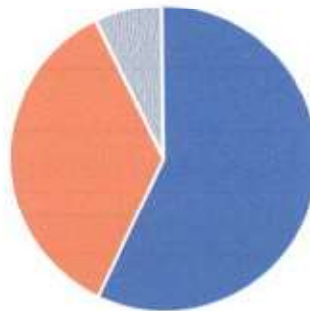

Ability of curriculum to contribute to the goal of the college



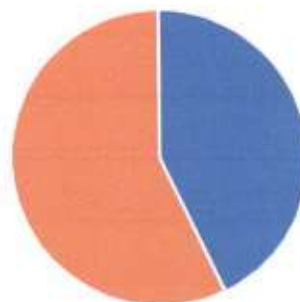

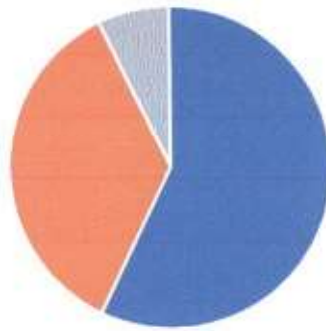

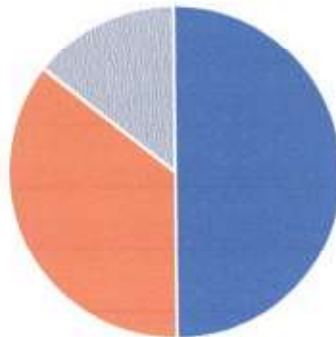

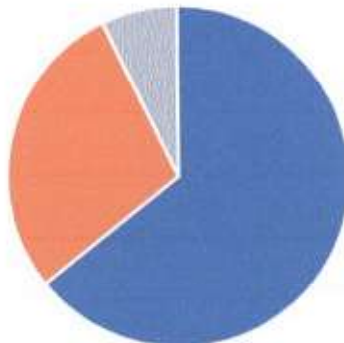

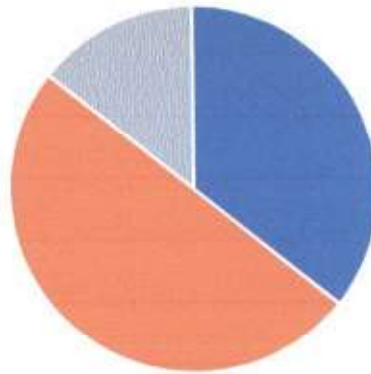

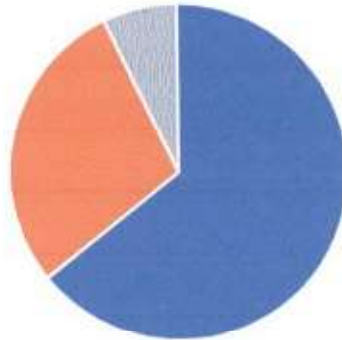

Curriculum support to enhance leadership qualities



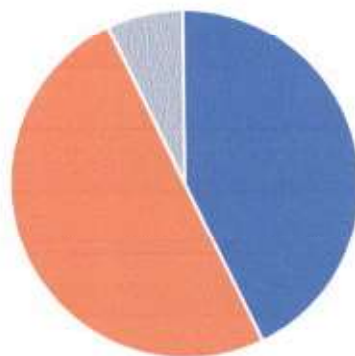

Role of curriculum in physical development

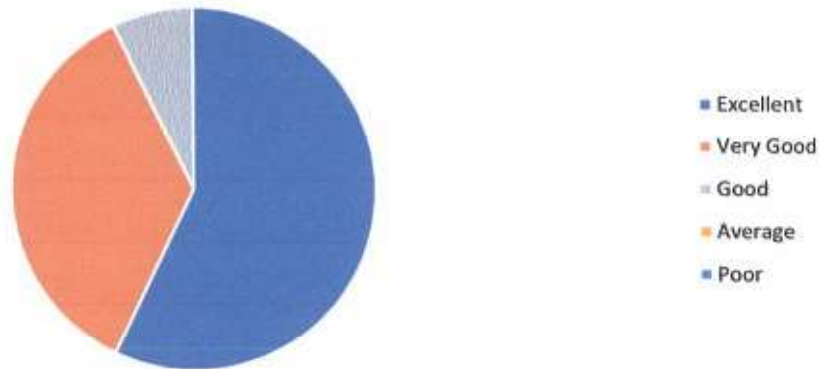
