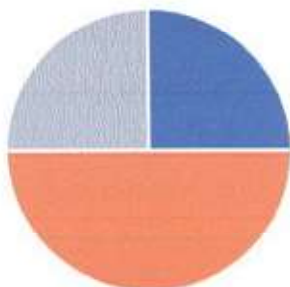

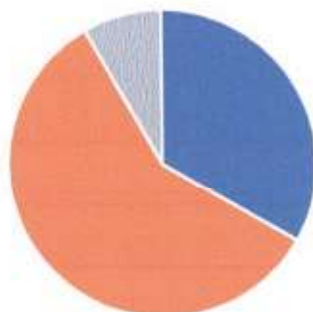

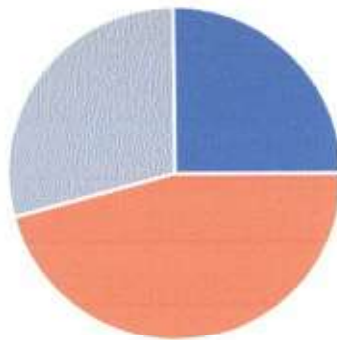

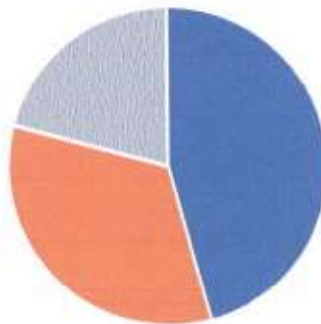

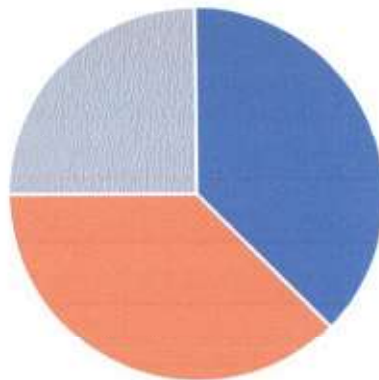

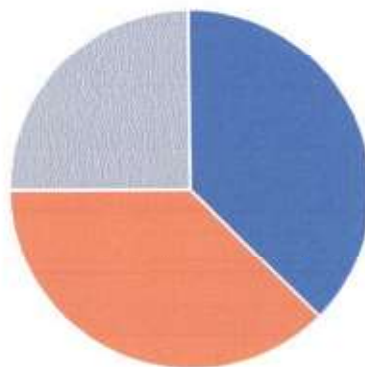

Role of curriculum in physical development

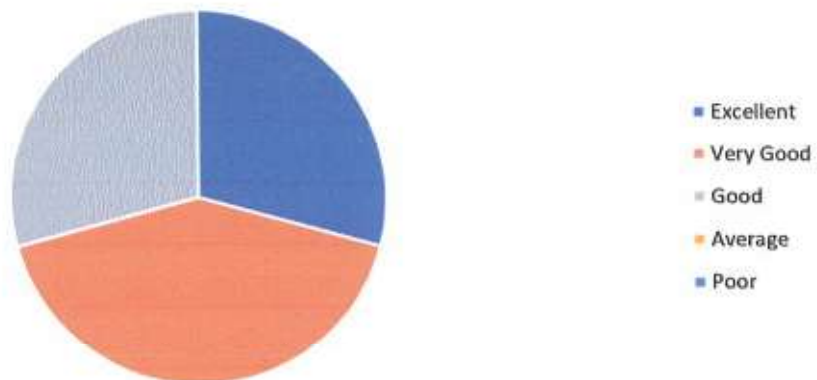
