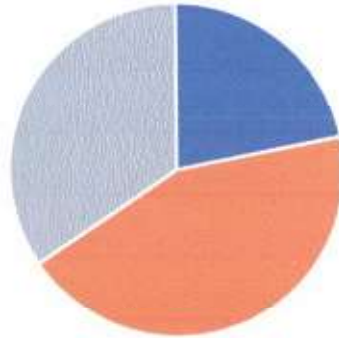

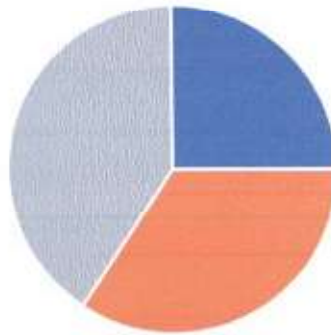

Ability of curriculum to contribute to the goal of the college



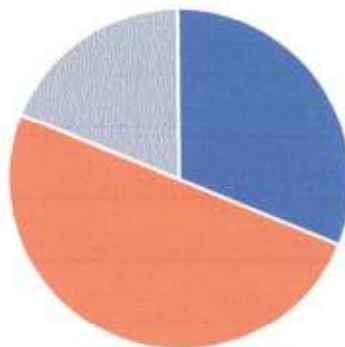

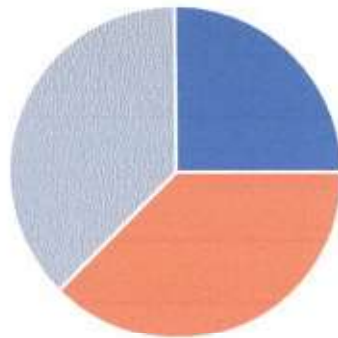

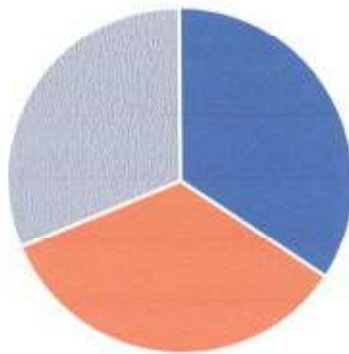

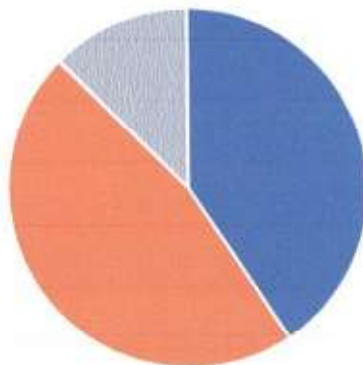

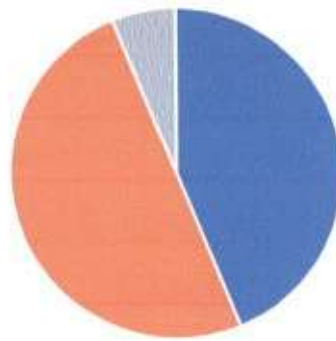

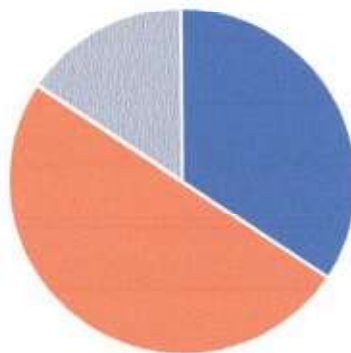

### Role of curriculum in physical development

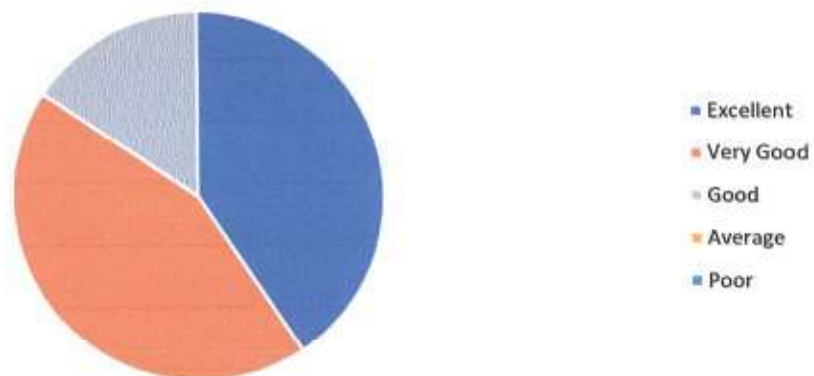
