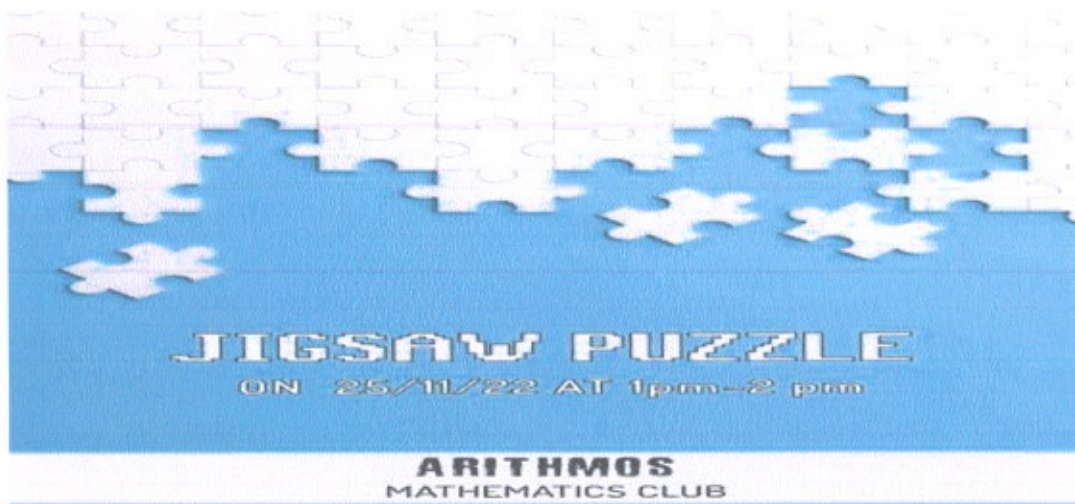

Fibonacci Day Celebration on 23-11 2022



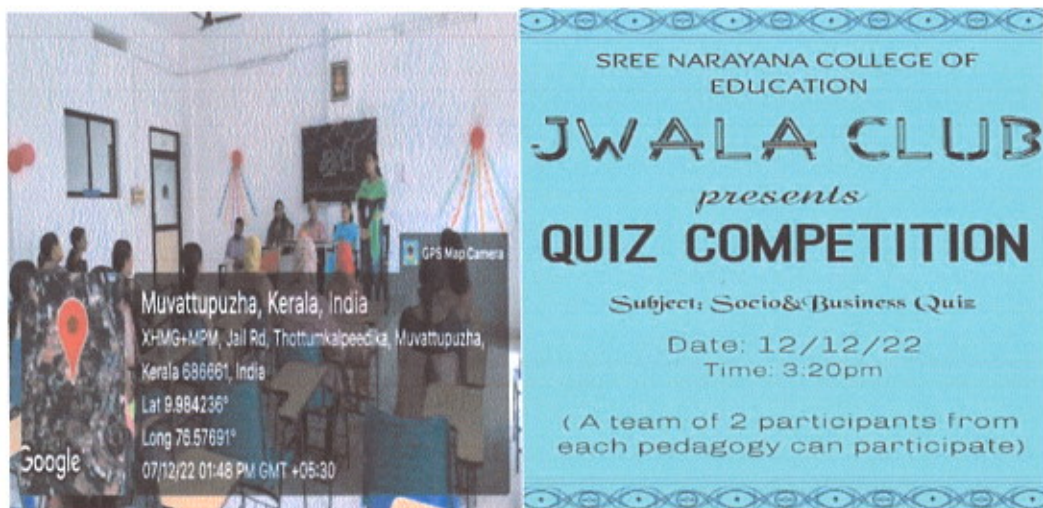

JWALA CLUB Inauguration on 7-12-2022

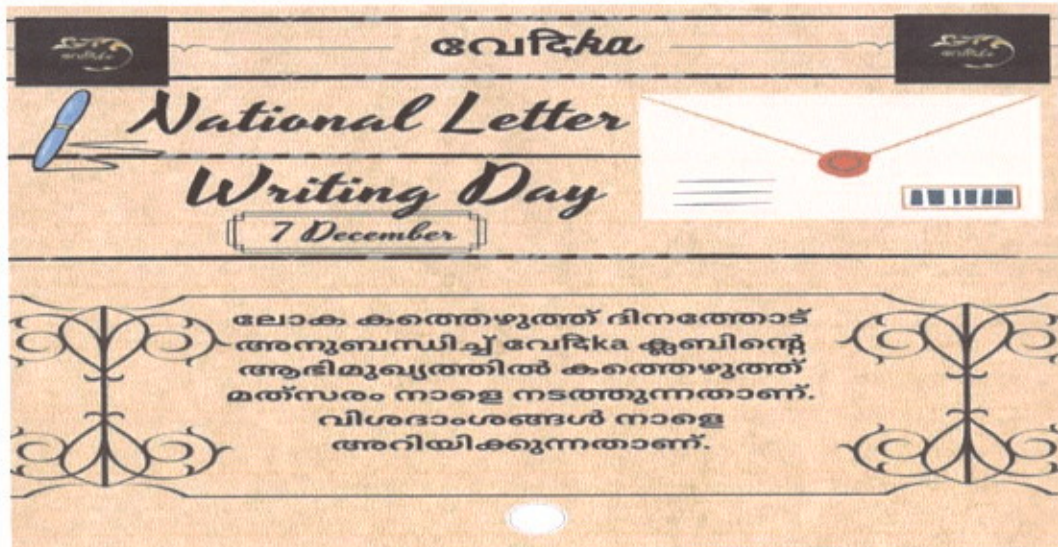

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CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION



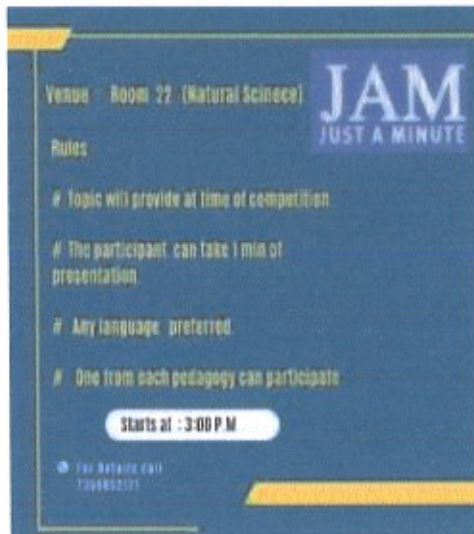
The Christmas celebration **HEY SANTA** was conducted on 21st December 2022, the celebration was inaugurated by manager Sri VK Narayanan

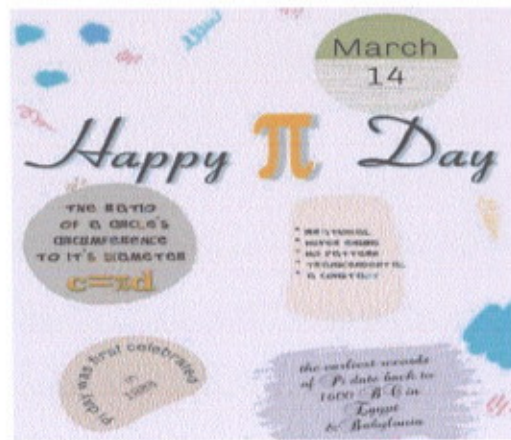
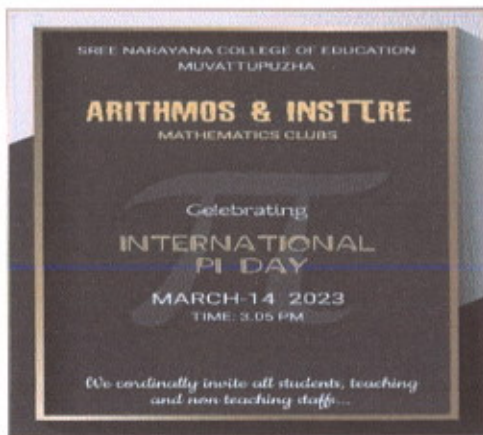
