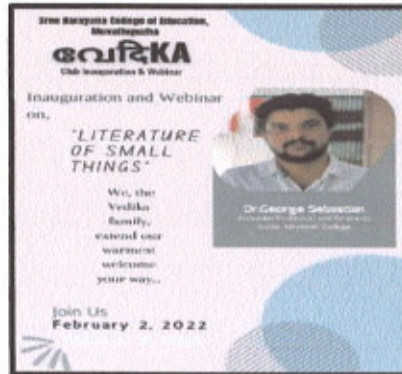
**Speech about how to handle children on Women's Day by

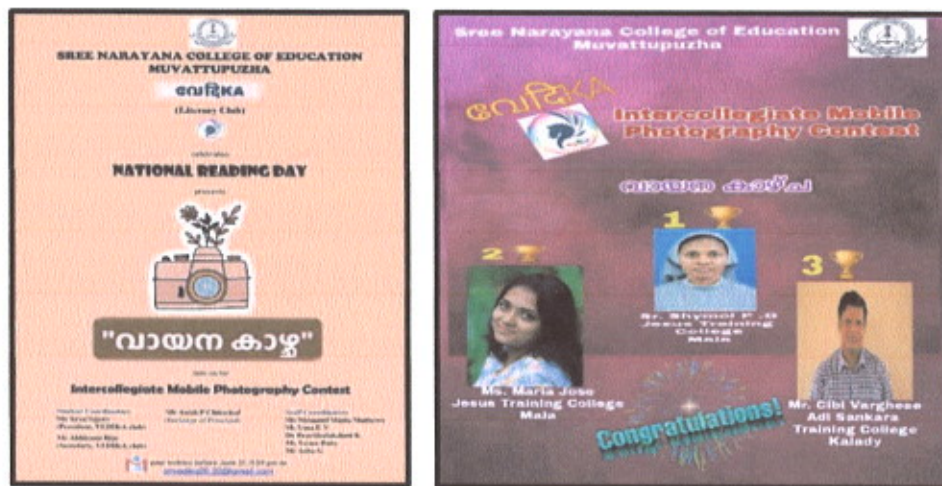

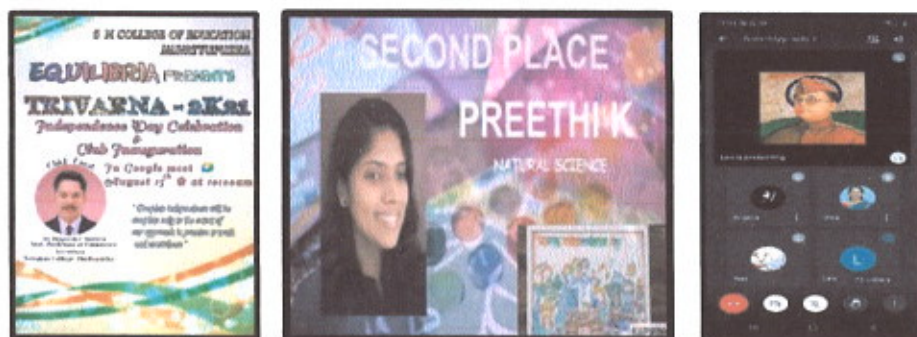

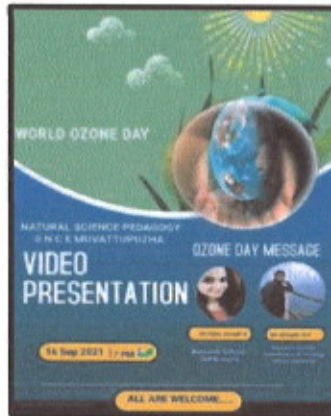


**Onam Celebrations by College Union, Sree Narayana College of Education on 18-08-2021**

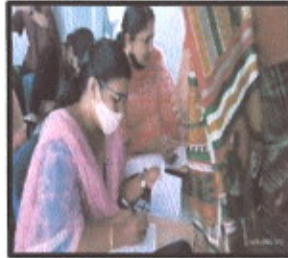
**Science Week Celebration by Science Club, Sree Narayana College of Education from 21/02/2022 to 25/02/2022**

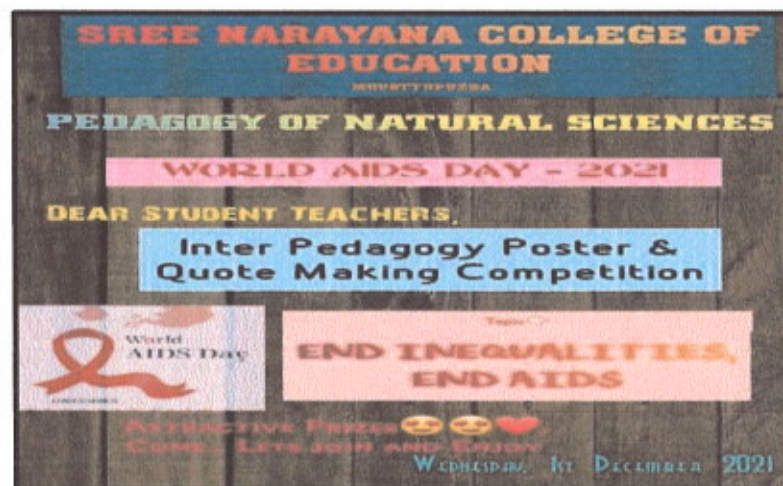
