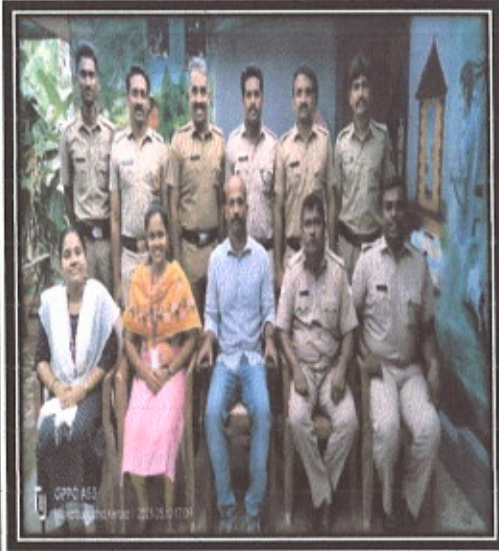

Creating awareness about the need of vaccination

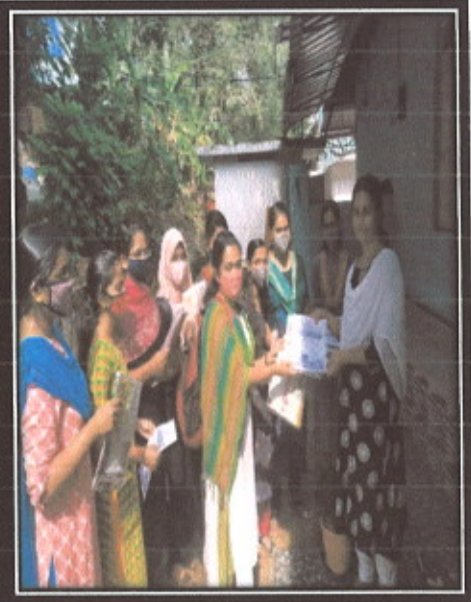

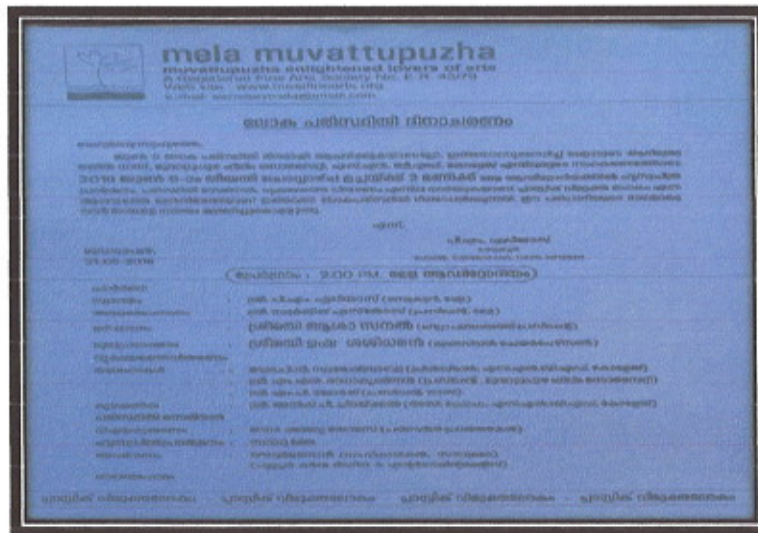

Programme Chart of Environment Day Celebrations at Mela, Muvattupuzha on 30.06.2018



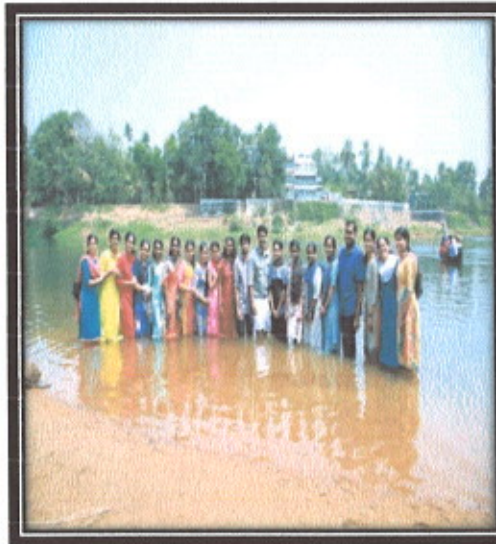

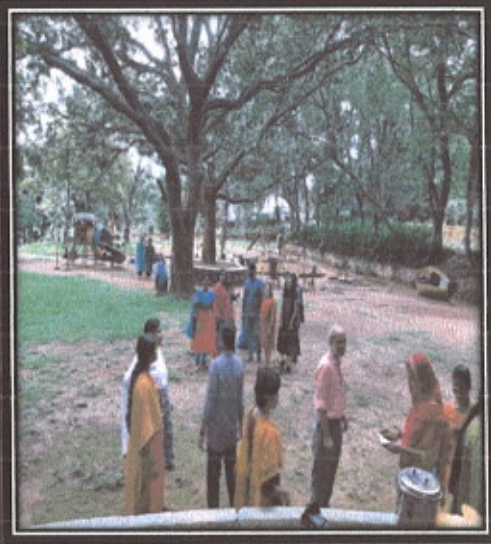

Community Practices and Challenges

Disaster Management Activities

1. In 2018 Kerala witnessed the most flood in August. There was a severe rainfall in Kerala and most of the dams were overflowed. There were landslides in high ranges and water logged in low areas. Students and teachers of Sree Narayana College of Education collected a fund and procured necessary materials like brooms, cloths and antiseptic liquid, disinfectants. They took initiatives to flood relief activities. Teachers, students and alumnus of SNCE visited the flood affected areas and cleaned many houses of ward 23. SN Group of institutions collected a good amount for flood relief which was handed over to the chief minister's flood relief fund by the management.

Chekkutty Dolls to help Chennamangalam Weavers Village

Chekkutty dolls / ChekkuttyPava : The doll from 'cheru' (Mud), doll of hope from the doomed looms of Chendamangalam. Kerala witnessed the worst floods in hundred years in August 2018. All the rivers, streams and many dams overflowed, there were landslides in the high ranges and low lying areas were submerged. It was nature striking back against human activities. But then this was also the time when human resilience came to the fore. The people of Kerala rose in unison and showed. Tremendous will power and fighting spirit and struggled against all the odds to quickly restore a semblance of normalcy to the state.

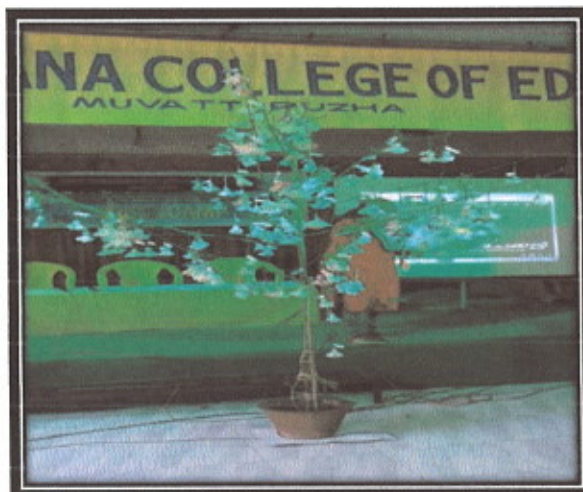

Chendamangalam is famous for traditional Kerala handlooms and in August 2018 they weaved Kerala sarees and dress materials for the festive season Onam. In 14th August 2018 water from the river Periyar and chalakudypuzha inundated the little village from two sides and the weavers lost everything in the flood- the looms, the woven fabrics and the raw materials. Ms Lakshmi Menon, a designer and entrepreneur, launched an effort to support the weavers in the time of crisis. She came up with an idea to recycle the bundles of mud stained cloth and use them to create small dolls. The weavers made dolls in large numbers and this was sold to the general public. The weavers of Chendamangalam rose against all the difficulties of flood with their damaged looms and muddied yarn. Around 20 students of Sree Narayana College of Education went to Chendamangalam for training to make Chekkutty dolls. The students came back to the college and conducted a workshop (07/02/2019) on doll making for all the students. The dolls thus made were sold to Staff, students and the public. The money collected was donated to the weavers.

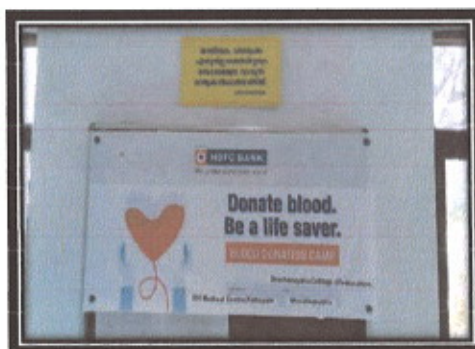
Blood donation camp

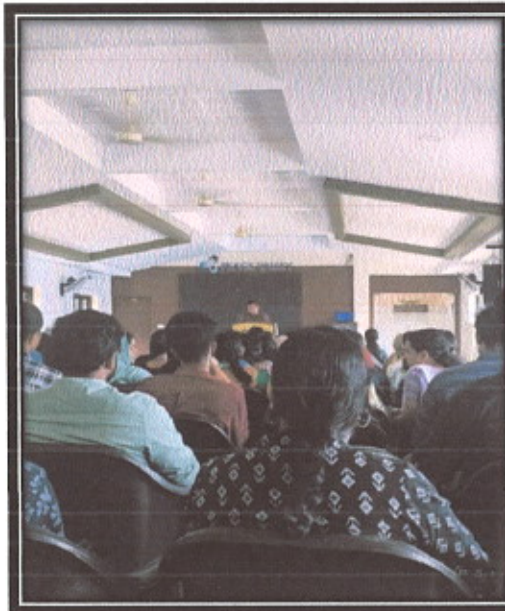

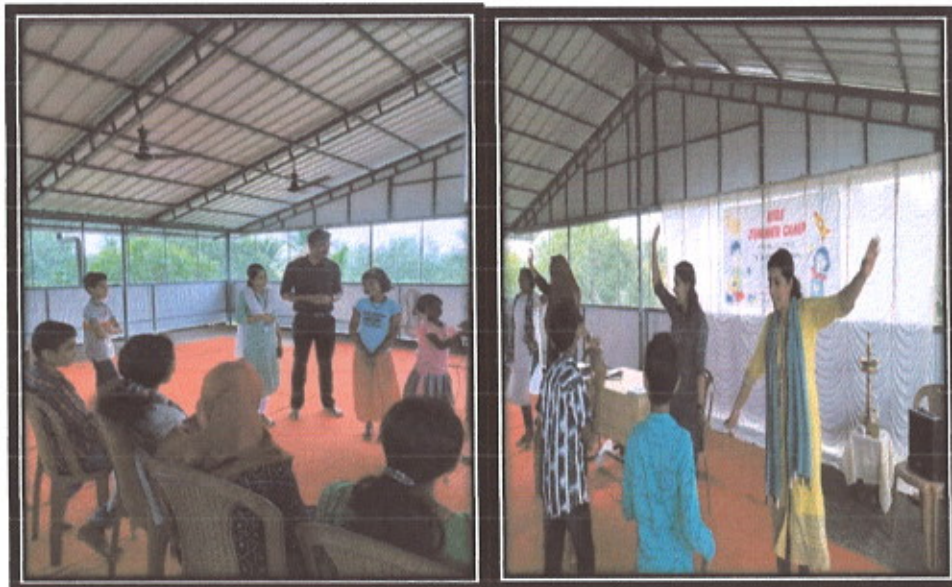

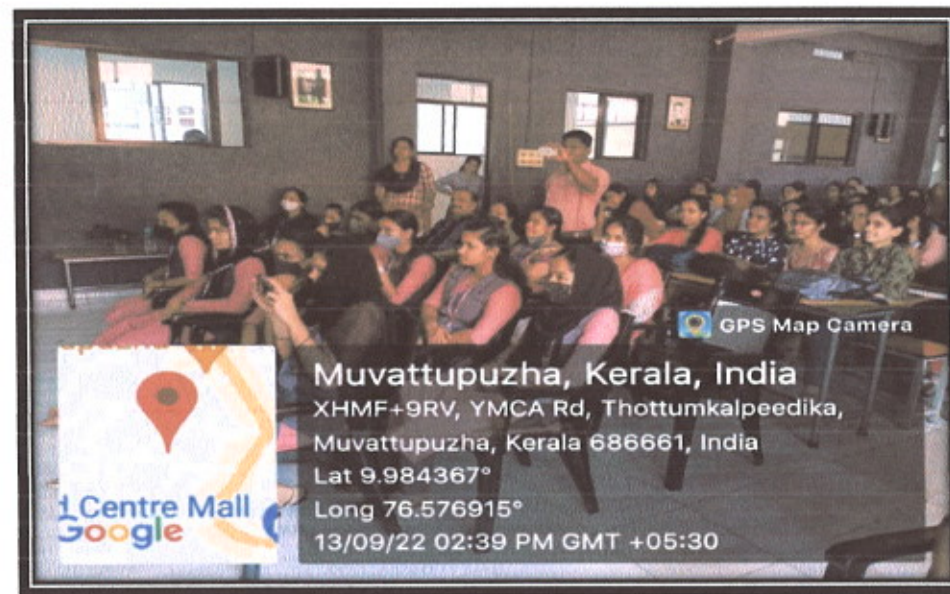
